





DISCOVER ASCOT & WINDSOR

With 240 acres of picturesque parkland, an equestrian centre, polo fields, a kids' club and plenty of outdoor pursuits, Coworth Park has more than enough to keep even the most active guest entertained. Nearby you can also discover breathtaking vistas, cultural gems and heritage sites in the local Berkshire towns and countryside.

EQUESTRIAN CENTRE AND POLO

Equestrian at Coworth Park provides stabling for up to 40 horses, with an experienced team of trainers offering support for beginners and seasoned riders alike. Coworth Park is the only UK hotel to feature its own polo fields and practice facilities, managed by Guards Polo Club.

COUNTRY PURSUITS

Walking and jogging maps are available from reception, and a broad range of outdoor sports and pursuits are offered including horse-riding, archery, laser clay pigeon shooting, falconry, fishing, mountain biking, tennis and croquet. Guests can also look forward to delicious picnics in the grounds, tailored to the individual's taste.

THEME PARKS

Open from April to October, Legoland Windsor is a short drive from the hotel whilst Thorpe Park, open between mid-March and early November, is only a 20-minute drive away.

SHOPPING

Near the hotel, discover some of Berkshire's best shopping in Windsor and Eton, from Windsor Royal Shopping Centre to fine boutiques and antiques shops offering handmade British souvenirs and gifts. Out of town, neighbouring Maidenhead is perfect for high street shopping, while the picture-postcard villages of Ascot, Cookham, Sunninghill and Sunningdale offer quirky boutiques, arts and crafts stores, florists and wine merchants.

COUNTRY

Coworth Park is located on the doorstep of Windsor Great Park, with a thousand acres of woodland, lakes and gardens, including The Savill Garden – one of the world's best temperate ornamental woodland gardens. Formerly the UK's largest man-made lake, Virginia Water is within walking distance of Coworth Park and features follies and the recently restored lakeside ruins of Leptis Magna.

HERITAGE & CULTURE

Windsor Castle, the town of Windsor and the River Thames are all only a stone's throw away, with Hampton Court Palace, Westminster, the Tower of London and the City of London further upriver.

SPORT & ACTION

A short drive from the hotel, Ascot hosts some of the race calendar's most prestigious events, such as Royal

Ascot in mid-June and Ascot Festival in late September.

The hotel's proximity to Wentworth Club makes it an ideal base for golf enthusiasts.

RESTAURANT COWORTH PARK

Located in the Mansion House, Michelin-starred Restaurant Coworth Park, with its relaxed elegance and contemporary setting overlooking parkland views, puts its own modern spin on classic British dishes. Seating up to 66 guests, the restaurant has three interconnecting rooms, the larger of which has floor-toceiling Georgian-style windows overlooking the gardens.

THE BARN

An informal restaurant and bar with rustic charm, featuring large glass doors opening onto a terrace for al fresco dining. The Barn seats up to 70 guests, and serves delicious brasserie-style food. The first floor bar and dining area provides an ideal place for drinks or private parties.

DRAWING ROOM

The Drawing Room offers a relaxed and refined atmosphere, cocktails, afternoon tea, and an opportunity to unwind by the fire or take in the scenic views of the terrace and beyond.

COTTAGES


The Cottages house a further 12 rooms and suites complete with bespoke contemporary furniture in a palette of warm colours.

NORTH LODGE


